### RSS @ West Vancouver Library

- West Vancouver Memorial Library uses RSS feeds to deliver information about new books, CDs, DVDs, etc. to your desktop via a RSS feed reader.
- The lists are updated every morning.
- Keep up with new titles in your subject area by subscribing to the feed.
- Find great new books to read/listen to and films to watch!

### How to I sign up for RSS feeds?

1. [www.reader.google.com](http://www.reader.google.com) is an easy free web-based reader.
2. Create an account with your e-mail address and a password.
3. Sign-up for West Vancouver Memorial Library feeds.
4. [www.westvanlibrary.ca](http://www.westvanlibrary.ca) > search catalogue > RSS feeds.
5. Click on a RSS button, ex. New Fiction, & copy the web address (URL).
5. In Google Reader, click “Add a subscription”
6. Paste (the feed web address) into the box, & click Add.
